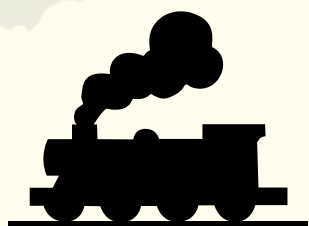

DESCRIPTION OF THE YOUTH EXCHANGE

The two primary categories of skill sets are Hard Skills and Soft Skills. Hard Skills consist of Technical and Academic Skills acquired through formal education, while Soft Skills encompass various positive qualities that make up one's personality. These qualities, such as effective communication, conflict resolution, and teamwork, are essential for job success and complement Hard Skills.

Developing Soft Skills is crucial as they determine a candidate's ability to showcase their Hard Skills effectively. Participants can systematically develop Soft Skills through awareness and interest in them. Soft Skills are important when selecting employees as they are personality-driven and reflect attitudes and intuitions.

The program aims to develop leadership skills and entrepreneurial thinking among participants, inspiring them to create new ideas, venture outside their comfort zone, take risks, and motivate themselves and others. The program also prepares participants to handle difficult situations, accept responsibility, and stand out from others for faster career growth.



Our goals will be achieved through the following objectives :

1. To inspire youth to have a better understanding of their skills, stimulate their abilities and their understanding how to improve them.
2. To encourage youngsters to make optimal use of their abilities and to share them with others.
3. To demonstrate participants different ways of acquiring and using their learning styles.
4. To promote Erasmus+ and Youth pass as a recognition tool for non-formal and informal learning.
5. To promote social and cultural inclusion, support non-formal and intercultural learning;
6. To develop youngsters awareness of understanding of other cultures, improve their sense of cooperation and build the network between the European and Non-European countries

We will refund only travel tickets that we approved prior purchase!

We kindly ask you to choose the most economical and eco-friendly way of transport (e.g. student fares, low cost airlines, 2nd class trains, etc.).

Also, be aware of your travel cost limitation. We reimburse the travel cost ONLY up to the limit designed for your country.

We will also reimburse only those ticket that will show:

1. the currency
2. dates of your travel
3. places you are traveling from/to and your name (or number of passengers).

It is important to keep all your tickets (also from your local buses and trains).

It is NOT possible to travel by car or taxi!

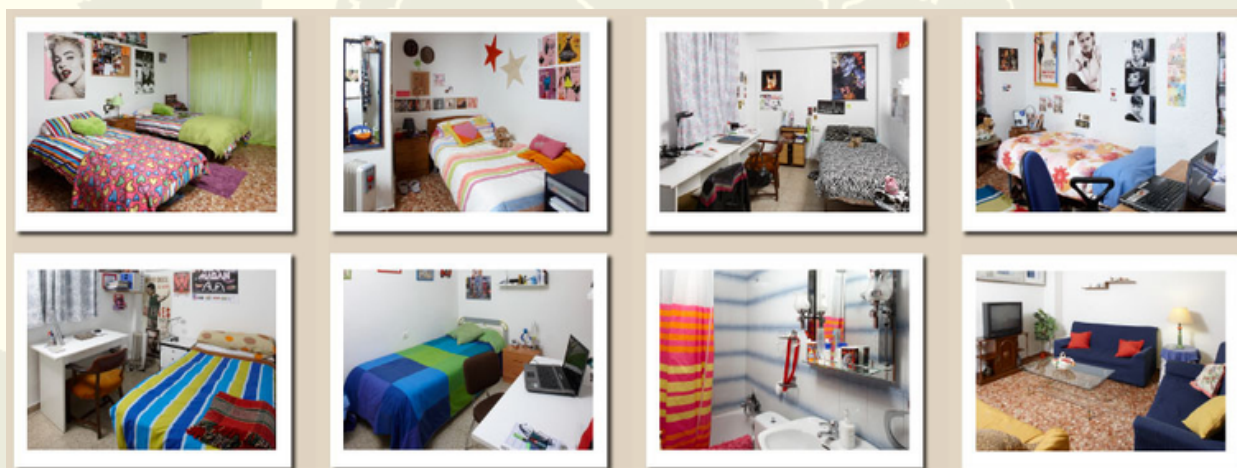
The travel costs within the budget limit of your country (please see above) will be reimbursed after the youth exchange to the bank account of your sending organisation and only if these 3 conditions are fulfilled:

- 1) You gave all the ORIGINAL tickets to our organization. It's fundamental to bring the invoices or the travel confirmations where is clearly shown the price;
- 2) You attended the full duration of the youth exchange;
- 3) You submitted all reports that our organization or EU requested.
- 4) We need PDF of boarding pass (QR code is not valid)

Staying at Nuestra Señora de Gracia dormitory is an extraordinary experience for students. The dormitory offers all possible facilities for students to feel at home

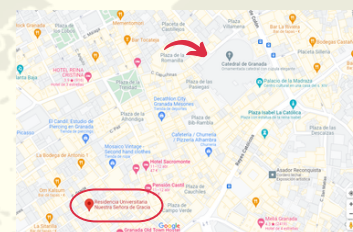


It offers 25 rooms, double and single, some of which with ensuite bathroom. We guarantee the quality of our hosting, with a healthy diet and a good rest.

WEATHER IN GRANADA

July is usually warm, with temperatures about 30 to 35°C. It might be warm in the morning, hot during the day and warm at night. The weather can vary, so please do check the weather forecast for Granada before you pack your suitcase.

VISA APPLICATION

In case you need visa, please apply for them immediately as we confirm your participation because it may take long time. If you need an invitation letter from us, please let us know.

INSURANCE, MEDICAL AND SAFETY ADVICES

Please, be aware that it is compulsory for all participants to have travel insurance covering the whole duration of your stay in Spain, including the days of your arrival and departure. Travel insurance cannot be covered by us, but you are obliged to arrange it by yourself when coming to Spain.

Most of the course will be held indoors. Take your medications – it is good to take pills from your country (you know yourself the best so take painkillers, antipyretic, something against cold that works for you).

Please bring your European Health Insurance Card (the blue one) in case of some emergency.

If you have any special needs (allergies, diets, disabilities, disadvantages, etc.), please state them clearly in the Application Form so we can arrange everything in advance and we do not meet the problem of solving your special needs problem after your arrival to the Spain. Also, please take your medication with yourself.
